Q: What inspired you to dive into the culinary arts?

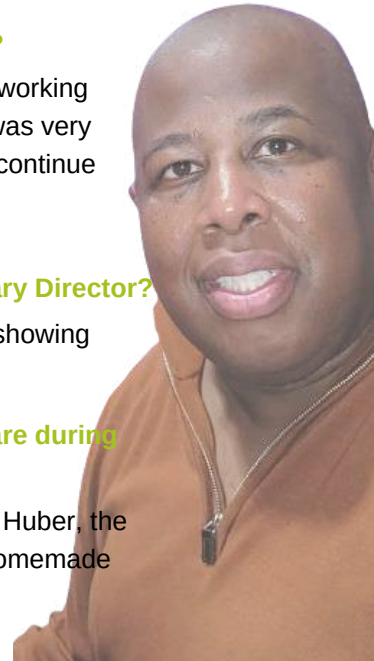
I grew up with a mother who was a chef. I remember working side by side with her in her catering business when I was very young. The time I spent with her really inspired me to continue in the culinary arts.
